

Upgrading: What it Takes to Upgrade and What You'll Gain

Upgrading from one system to another can be either very low cost, or very expensive depending on what system you have, what system you want to upgrade to, and how many throttles you have. Many of these upgrades require you to purchase another booster. In this case, you can use your current booster for additional track power or auto reversing. If you don't need it for either of these things, you can sell it, or have us sell it for you with our consignment service.

Another Brand

Upgrading from another brand requires the purchase of a Digitrax starter set.

The Throttles and Command Station will not be usable with a Digitrax system. However, non Digitrax boosters can be used as slaves if wired properly. If you need to do this, check with us for the proper wiring. If we don't already know how to do it, chances are we can find out for you. Or, you can sell the boosters along with the throttle and command station, and get more Digitrax boosters for slaves. Of course, all your existing decoders will work just fine.

After you upgrade to a Digitrax system, we can help you find a buyer for your used equipment.
